The Foundation for the Law of Time was established in 2000 and serves as a vehicle to disseminate the visionary work of Dr. Jose Argüelles. 2012 marks the 20th annual Day Out of Time and in this auspicious year we will honor the work of Dr. Argüelles for his creation of planetary Art, specifically, The World Thirteen Moon Calendar Change Peace Movement. The Thirteen Moon Galactic Calendar is used worldwide to assist people in returning to natural time. Dr. Argüelles founded the Day Out of Time with his wife Lloydine Argüelles in 1992. The Argüelles' aligned with the Roerich Banner of Peace, (Nicholas Roerich, 1847-1947, (www.roerich.org/nr.html?mid=pact) an emblem for the desire of human culture to rise above war. This flag has been flown globally as a sign of peace and culture since the 1930's.

The Free Day event is also modeled after the historic "Human Be-In" that occurred in January 1967 in Golden Gate Park. The Human Be-In sometimes referred to as a Love-In was specifically designed by artist Michael Bowen to be imitated and to be remembered into the future. Bowen considered the Human Be-In performance art. We pay tribute to Bowen with our 2012 version, a HUMAN-BE-LOVE-IN.

Celebration and Ceremony Honor Living in Natural Time

For a small but passionate band of people throughout the world, New Year's Day is marked by a distant star outside our solar system and time is honored as a field of consciousness. These people share teachings that are rooted in the hidden mathematics of the Mayan Calendar designed to calibrate our planet with the "synchronic order" of the cosmos. Every year, on the Gregorian calendar date July 25, the followers of this teaching celebrate a "Day Out of Time," also called the Free Day or Green Day.

The Free Day is literally free. No money is exchanged, no goods are sold, no admission price is charged and nobody is paid. It is a holiday from the dominant time-is-money mental state and a celebration of what they believe is the true nature of time: Time-Is-Art. It is also the official holiday between solar years, because the New Year in the Natural Time movement launches on July 26, the day that the star Sirius appears as a dawn star. The Day Out of Time is at once a celebration and an opportunity to forgive the transgressions and difficulties of the preceding year and start fresh in the year to come.

The 2012 Day Out of Time has particular significance since the year that begins on July 26 encompasses the end of the 5125-year great cycle identified in the Mayan Long Count calendar as the end of the Fifth Sun and beginning of the Sixth Sun. The first mention of this in the non-academic world came through the message of the Harmonic Convergence in 1987 by Dr. José Argüelles, who elaborated on its significance for the next 25 years in books, lectures, Internet commentaries and ceremonial presentations throughout the world. Dr. Argüelles died in March of 2011, declaring that his work as a galactic messenger was complete.

The imprint of his effort is witnessed in the various ceremonies throughout the planet on the Day Out of Time, including an annual acknowledgement in San Francisco in Golden Gate Park. This year, 20 years after the launching of the first Day Out of Time celebration, the followers of the calendar and the "Dreamspell" count based on Dr. Argüelles' interpretation of the galactic Mayan system of harmonics are inviting the public to join their celebration at the Main Concourse Band Shell in Golden Gate Park from noon to 6 p.m. with a program of music, dance, ceremony, meditation and information-sharing.

The location of San Francisco has a strong significance for this celebration, harkening both to the historic Human-Be-In initiated by artist Michael Bowen in 1967 and to the distribution of first Dreamspell kits in December 1991 at an event at the Dakin Center on Sacramento Street. Five hundred Dreamspell kits, containing the essential teachings of Mayan harmonics developed by Dr. Argüelles and his wife Lloydine, were given away at that event, formally beginning an intense planetary effort to wake up people to the importance of consciously joining the synchronic order with a 13-based calendar of natural time.

The World Thirteen Moon Calendar Change Peace Plan was launched and publication of alternative 13-Moon 28-Day calendars in many languages and many shapes and sizes soon followed. Today, the Foundation of the Law of Time (www.lawoftime.org) is the root source for Argüelles' legacy and also offers free calendars each year to help people learn to convert their awareness of time from the meaningless hodge-podge of the irregular 12-month Gregorian calendar to the elegance of a 13-based synchronometer that links human rhythms to the rhythms of all creation. As its advocates frequently point out, there are 13 full moons a year and women have 13 ovulations a year, a understanding that was once the foundation of tribal societies entrained into the natural world--a world that unified the grand celestial mechanisms with the daily life of human society.

The Golden Gate Park celebration this year, known as the Human-Be-Love-In, will offer free information on the calendars and related resources being published on the west coast. It will offer opportunities for people to understand the significance of restoring time to its natural dimension, a dimension that exists as consciousness and sources all manifestation. Argüelles taught that true time, not mechanical time, is the realm of creation and the role of the human in time is to reflect consciousness through creativity. In 2013, according to Argüelles, the human being will make a dramatic shift to galactic consciousness receiving, in his words, "a new blueprint." This is the significance of the Mayan information carved in stone 1300 years ago and left for future scientists to decipher as the end of the "era of history" approached.

Participants at the Free Day event will also be invited to join the unified planetary meditation for the "Rainbow Bridge," one of the last inspirations of Dr. Argüelles' long and rich life. The Rainbow Bridge is a creative visualization of energies entering the poles of the Earth and activating auroras encircling the planet to uplift the spirit of humanity and harmonize with the actual energies emanating from the Milky Way galaxy and the sun.

A program of music and dance by Bay Area performers will highlight the celebration. [details forthcoming]
